**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PENNS GROVE**

**Chapter 110 – Personnel Policies**

**Article III – Direct Deposit.**

**§ 110 – 6       Mandatory Positions.**

All full-time employees and elected officials who receive compensation from the Borough of Penns Grove are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of September 1, 2020 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f(b).


**§ 110 – 7       Exempt Positions.**

Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the Borough of Penns Grove are exempt from the direct deposit mandate in § 110 – 7.


**§ 110 – 8       Requests for Exemption.**

Municipal employees may request, in writing, an exemption from the direct deposit mandate in § 110 – 7 to the Municipal Clerk. Such requests will be presented to the Governing Body at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Governing Body after the request is received by the Chief Financial Officer. The Governing Body may grant such an exemption by Resolution and for good cause.
