**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
THE TOWNSHIP OF PINE DECLARING BIRD MIGRATION  
SEASONS AND THE "LIGHTS OUT" PROGRAM TO  
PROMOTE SAFE BIRD MIGRATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Pine was established as a Bird Town in 2025 and there are street signs in the Township promoting dedication to the effort; and

WHEREAS, most bird migration in the United States of America occurs in the Spring between April 1<sup>st</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup> and in the Fall between August 15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>; and

WHEREAS, World Migratory Bird Day is officially celebrated on the second Saturday in May (May 10, 2025) and the second Saturday in October (October 11, 2025); and

WHEREAS, an estimated 1,000,000,000 birds are killed each year due to nighttime light pollution; and

WHEREAS, bird migration is one of nature's great wonders; and

WHEREAS, birds typically follow established flyways, which are routes that offer the best opportunities for rest and refueling along the way; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pine is part of a flyway the birds use; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Township of Pine will promote safe bird migration practices during the Spring and Fall migration dates of April 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup>.
